INTRO TO NEOTROPICAL RESEARCH AND CULTURE

What is this program?

Twelve applicants will be selected for a 10 week program of research and cultural experiences in Panama.

What will you gain from participating in this program?

- Neotropical research experience
- Greater understanding of tropical biology
- Expanded knowledge of Latin American culture
- Opportunity to improve your foreign language skills (English or Spanish)

Who is eligible?

Undergraduates, recent graduates (post-bachelor's), and early-stage graduate students. Individuals with at least some knowledge of both English and Spanish are highly encouraged to apply.

What will interns receive?

- Airfare, housing, and food* allowance
- A monthly stipend of \$250 to cover miscellaneous living expenses
- A research stipend of \$200 for books and research supplies

* \$300/month except where meals are provided
